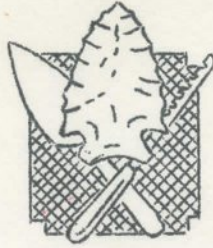

THE APRIL MEETING

A good turnout of members at the April meeting heard an excellent talk by Dr. Robert C. Dailey on the ever-popular topic of Ontario Archaeology.

After a brief resume of the field work carried out in Ontario since the turn of the century, Dr. Dailey made use of a blackboard, colour slides, and a small collection of artifacts to describe the type of archaeological sites one could expect to encounter in our province, show where these sites might be found, explain the methods used during excavation and artifact analysis, and point up the problems encountered in interpreting the data obtained.

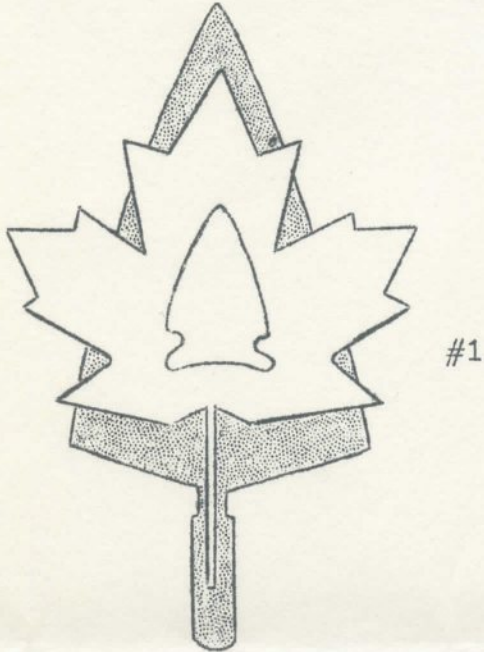
THE SPRING "DIG"

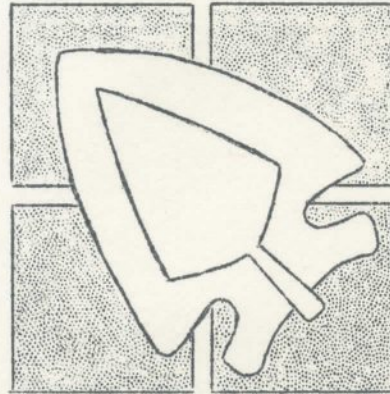
THE SOCIETY CREST

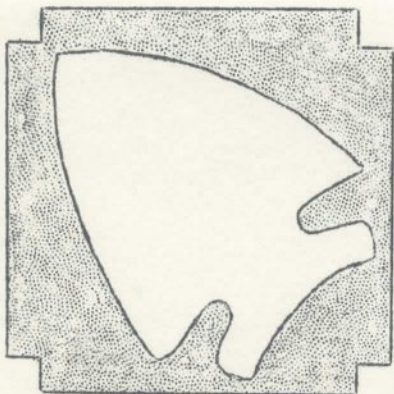

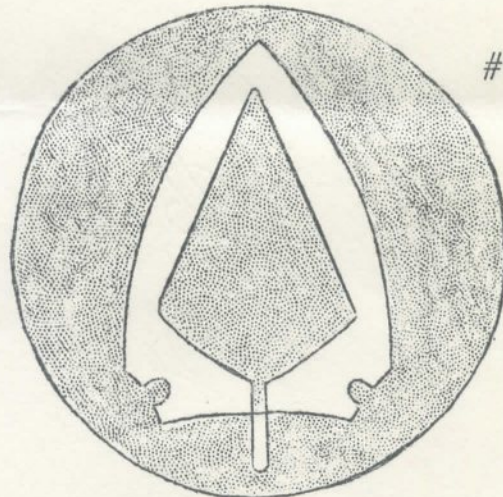

The current issue of the Anthropological Journal of Canada (Vol. 4, No. 2) carries a well illustrated report by Frank Ridley that should prove to be a good basic reference work for others in the northeastern Ontario field. Entitled "Archaeology of Lake Abitibi, Ontario - Quebec", it describes Mr. Ridley's work in that area and attempts to establish a 4000 year chronological sequence within the temporal framework provided by the stratified Frank Bay and Sheguiandah sites.
